Article 1 Subject

1.1 The subject of the contract shall be:

the “Supply of equipment for offices, for extension departments and artificial insemination centres”. The supply contract will include the supply, delivery, siting and installation, commissioning and after sale service of the following supplies:

The place of acceptance of the supplies shall be <insert place>, the time limits for delivery shall be <insert date and time> and the Incoterm applicable shall be [DDP] [DAP]⁴. - 1.2 The contractor shall comply strictly with the terms of the special conditions and the technical annex.
- 1.3 The supplies which form the subject of the contract must be accompanied by the spare parts described by the contractor in its tender and by the accessories and other items necessary for using the goods over a period of 2 years, as specified in the instructions to tenderers.

Article 2 Origin

The rules of origin of the goods are defined in Article 10 of the special conditions.

When required, a certificate of origin for the goods must be provided by the contractor at the latest when it requests provisional acceptance of the goods. Failure to comply with this condition may result in the termination of the contract and/or suspension of payment.

Article 3 Price

- 3.1 The price of the supplies shall be that shown on the financial offer (specimen in Annex IV). The total maximum contract price shall be in EURO.
- 3.2 Payments shall be made in accordance with the general and/or special conditions (Articles 26 to 28).

Article 4 Order of precedence of contract documents

The contract is made up of the following documents, in order of precedence:

- the contract agreement;
- the special conditions
- the general conditions (Annex I);
- the technical specifications (Annex II [including clarifications before the deadline for submission of tenders and minutes from the information meeting/site visit];
- the technical offer (Annex III [including clarifications from the tenderer provided during tender evaluation]);
- the budget breakdown (Annex IV);
- [specified forms and other relevant documents (Annex V)];

The various documents making up the contract shall be deemed to be mutually explanatory; in cases of ambiguity or divergence, they shall prevail in the order in which they appear above.

Article 5 Other specific conditions applying to the contract
